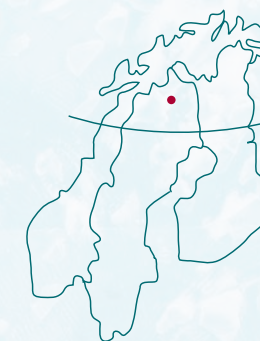

We look forward to see you at ICEHOTEL and in Jukkasjärvi, 200 km above the Arctic Circle in Sweden. Here, the nature is untouched with about 6 000 lakes and six grand rivers. One of the rivers is Torne River, which supplies ICEHOTEL with enough ice to build an entire hotel – every year. The name Jukkasjärvi derives from a Sami word, meaning "meeting place". The village is a historical trading site where people from far and near have met since ancient times. Today, people meet at ICEHOTEL, sharing experiences, encountering nature and culture, and enjoying the ice and art – year-round. Welcome to experience ICEHOTEL!

ICEHOTEL HAS ACTIVITIES and experiences for everyone. With nature around the corner, you can unwind outdoors on your own accord or head out on an activity to experience the untouched wilderness, every day of the year.

Year-round

Every season is unique in the Arctic and ICEHOTEL is open every day. Experience new things year-round.

MIDWINTER: The landscape is covered in thick snow, the temperature drops and the winter's ice suites open. Experience the northern lights and the pastel-colored midwinter light Kaamos that can only be seen in the polar region.



POLAR NIGHT: The sun doesn't rise for a month from December to January, and the few hours of indirect daylight create a magical blue light.



ICE HARVEST: The ice from Torne River is harvested in March and April to be used for next year's winter suites, ice glasses and ice art.



SPRING-WINTER: By the end of March, the days are getting longer and the weather gets milder. It is a perfect period for ice fishing and cross-country skiing. The winter suites are slowly starting to melt back into Torne River.



Do: **SAY YES!**

Marry in the midst of winter or height of summer – the sub-zero setting is available year-round. You can also spend your honeymoon on ice – start your ever-after in an ephemeral setting, making the memories of your stay even more cherished. ICEHOTEL has an in-house wedding coordinator who can help you create the perfect love story, suitable for you.



Learn: **A GUIDED TOUR** of ICEHOTEL is a must. Learn about the history behind the innovative hotel made of ice and snow, which is also one of Sweden's largest and most unique private art exhibitions. HARVEST TIME

If you visit ICEHOTEL in March, you have an opportunity to experience the ice harvest. Watch as the yard-thick ice blocks are lifted out of the crystal clear Torne River and stored until next year's hotel, ice glasses, ice plates and bars.

EXPERIENCE THE SUN IN THE MIDDLE OF THE NIGHT

The 24-hour daylight is characteristic for Swedish Lapland during the summer months. Join the Midnight Sun tour and experience Jukkasjärvi's surroundings with a guide to different viewpoints – where you can see the golden midnight sun paired with breathtaking nature.

MIDNIGHT SUN: From the middle of May and 50 days forward, the sun never sets. The 24-hour daylight invites to an active vacation. The landscape bathes in the golden light and nature awakens.



SUMMER: Take in the vibrant summer green on a hike, river rafting or fishing tour – any hour of the day. Experience winter inside and summer outside.

LATE SUMMER: The evenings are getting darker and cooler. The first northern lights of the season can be seen as early as late August. This is a perfect time for picking berries and mushrooms.



FALL: The colors of nature explode in red, orange and yellow, the air gets cold and crisp and the first frost appears. Hearty meals, inspired by the harvest season, are served at ICEHOTEL Restaurant.

WINTER: The first snow usually sets in October and the river starts to freeze. The building of the winter suites starts – a perfect time to visit ICEHOTEL for those who want to get behind the scenes.

A walk in the hometown of ICEHOTEL

WALK 800 METERS to the end of the village. On the little cape, you'll find the historical Jukkasjärvi Church and the Old Homestead, dating back to the 1600s. Make sure to see the colorful art in the church and admire the well-preserved rustic timbered buildings of the Homestead.



TORNE RIVER IS the essence of ICEHOTEL and has always been of great importance to locals. Stand on its frozen body and watch the northern lights in winter, or cruise downstream and fish from it during summer.

THE MOUNTAIN PUIMONEN is perfect for hiking year-round, and offers breathtaking views from the top – a perfect Instagram-spot! Ask for a map in the reception.

THERE ARE ARTWORKS made of magnetite scattered around ICEHOTEL. Stroll the area and discover the sculptures.

DELUXE SUITE

Get a luxurious ICEHOTEL experience and stay a night in sub-zero degrees amongst pristine ice- and snow art, created by select artists from all over the world. Each deluxe room has a warm private en-suite with toilet, shower or bathtub, sauna and relax. Double rooms, available year-round.

ART SUITE

Sleep in $-5^{\circ}\text{C}/23^{\circ}\text{F}$, surrounded by hand carved ice- and snow art from artists across the globe. Double, triple or 4-bed rooms. Available as both winter suites and year-round.



ICE ROOM

Get the experience of a night in sub-zero degrees in a standard ice room atop an ice bed. Double, triple or 4-bed rooms. Only available during the winter season.



1. Dress down!

One base layer is enough, and should consist of long johns, a long sleeved top, wool socks and a hat. Your body heat will keep the sleeping bag warm, and the sleeping bag will insulate against the cold.

2. Tuck it in!

The sleeping bags at ICEHOTEL will keep you warm to temperatures as low as $-30^{\circ}\text{C}/-22^{\circ}\text{F}$ (ICEHOTEL's indoor temperature is only $-5^{\circ}\text{C}/23^{\circ}\text{F}$). Pick up your sleeping bag from Riverside Lobby just before you tuck yourself in for the night to keep it nice and toasty.

3. Rise and shine!

You'll be surprised on how well you slept in the sub-zero setting. A guide will wake you up in the morning with hot lingonberry juice. Start your day with a sauna in Riverside Lobby and indulge in the tasty breakfast buffet at ICEHOTEL Restaurant.

Food & drinks

TORNE VALLEY TRADITIONS,
Sami culture and Swedish classics have all influenced Jukkasjärvi and the food at ICEHOTEL. Flavors of nature, lingonberries, cloudberries and fir are combined with reindeer, moose and Arctic char, some served on a piece of Torne River ice. Finish your night with a drink in the rock at ICEBAR BY ICEHOTEL Jukkasjärvi.

Torne River

The mother of ICEHOTEL

TORNE RIVER with its impressive length of 520 kilometers, is the largest of Sweden's four national rivers and one of the last untouched rivers in Europe. It's Torne River that provides ICEHOTEL with its ice in winter – and when the art and parts of the hotel melt, the water returns to its source again. ICEHOTEL exists in a cycle that follows that of the Torne River. During winter, the ice from the river becomes art, design, and architecture. In the summer, the water and the midnight sun transform the landscape into a lush river valley.



Ice experiences cooled by the sun

The days are long during summer, 200 km above the Arctic Circle, and from the middle of May to mid-July, the sun never sets, blessing the region with 24-hour daylight – the midnight sun.

The sustainable energy helps to run the cooling system, making it possible to experience ice and snow year-round.

800m²
of solar panels harness the energy from the sun, and helps to keep ICEHOTEL cool throughout summer.



A PERMANENT ICEHOTEL

The arrival of spring has always been a sign of ICEHOTEL's return to Torne River. But thanks to sustainable solar power, a night on ice and snow is possible year-round in the permanent part of ICEHOTEL. The permanent part of ICEHOTEL has 9 Deluxe Suites with private sauna, bathroom and relax, and 11 Art Suites, an ice gallery and ICEBAR by ICEHOTEL Jukkasjärvi; all hand carved by select artists from around the globe.

The making of ICEHOTEL

WHEN THE COLD arrives to the Arctic, the river slows down and the landscape transforms. This marks a period of intense activity on the riverbank in Jukkasjärvi – ICEHOTEL is being reborn. Huge blocks of ice, weighing two tons apiece, were harvested from the river the previous winter and have been stored in anticipation of the new build. At the end of November, artists from all over the world come to Jukkasjärvi to be a part of ICEHOTEL and turn their ideas into reality. Together with builders, the art support and lightning team, a new hotel emerges, filled with amazing ice art.



30,000

In order to create the seasonal part of ICEHOTEL, 30,000 cubic meter snice, a mixture of ice and snow, is used.



Snow-How

Every year, artists from all over the world are selected to be a part of a creative symposium, creating an ephemeral art exhibition of ice and snow that is ICEHOTEL. When the artists arrive in Jukkasjärvi they are given an introduction to the tools that are used for ice sculpting and how the materials behave when you work with them. Throughout the construction process, a team of experienced ice sculptors, the art support team, oversees the artists' progress, offering advice and support along the way.



3,000

3,000 tons of crystal clear natural ice is harvested from the river and used to create the art, ice glasses and ice bars.

1,000

For the chandeliers that are hanging in the breathtaking Main Hall, 1,000 hand-polished ice crystals are used.

The light that gives life

The lightning at ICEHOTEL adds an extra dimension. In the interplay between art, design and lighting, effects are created that emphasize and reinforce the transparent ice and white snow. There are many challenges: the light source must not give off heat, it should be set at the right angle to achieve the desired effect and, as an observer, you should not see the light installation itself, just experience it. Everything is customized on site in close dialogue with the artists.

White Desert

INSPIRED BY THE mysterious Egyptian art and architecture, and the vast winter landscape of the Arctic, this room intrigues. The Egyptian White Desert and northern dunes of snow have merged in this suite. A group of triangular shapes of different sizes are

placed at the entrance of the room. Perhaps it's the Egyptian pyramids, or the tops of traditional Sami tents in the distance?

“Geometry can be used as a language, and with that as a base we have created a minimal, yet cozy and emotional room.”

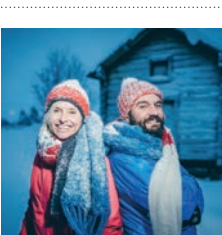

Cumulus

IMAGINE YOURSELF laying in a summer meadow. Shoes off, looking up, your thoughts begin to float along with the puffy clouds. How would it feel to be surrounded by these white sculptures of the sky? In this suite you can get the impossible experience of

being inside a cloud, a space made of concave round forms acts as a second skin, simultaneously infinite and intimate.

rest in her soothing, safe embrace. “We want the guests to feel as if they’re part of something magic, being able to rest while protected and embraced by the surrounding shelter of the fairytale creature’s tranquil chamber.”

A Rich Seam

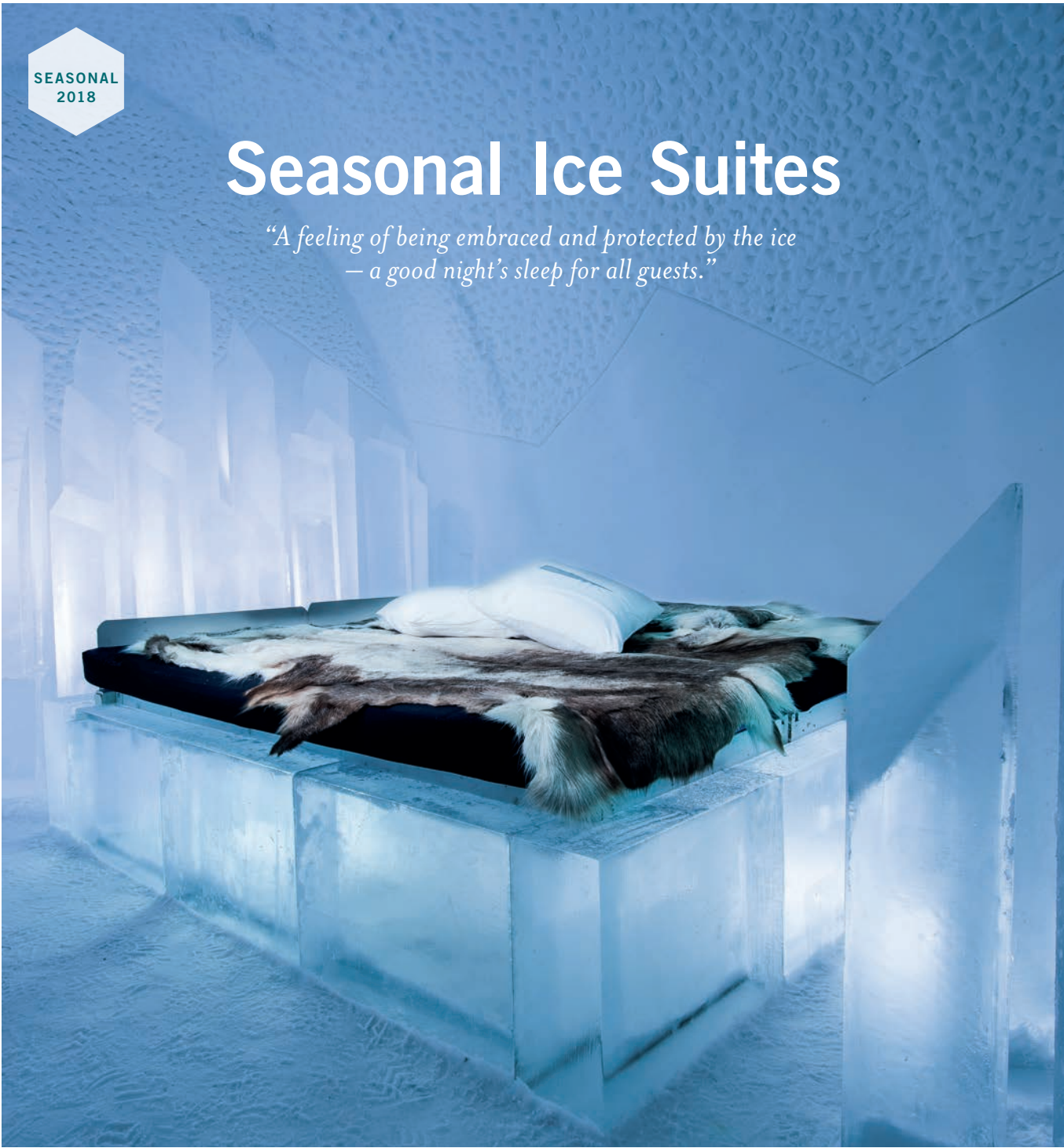
*“Is there more? Follow the path,

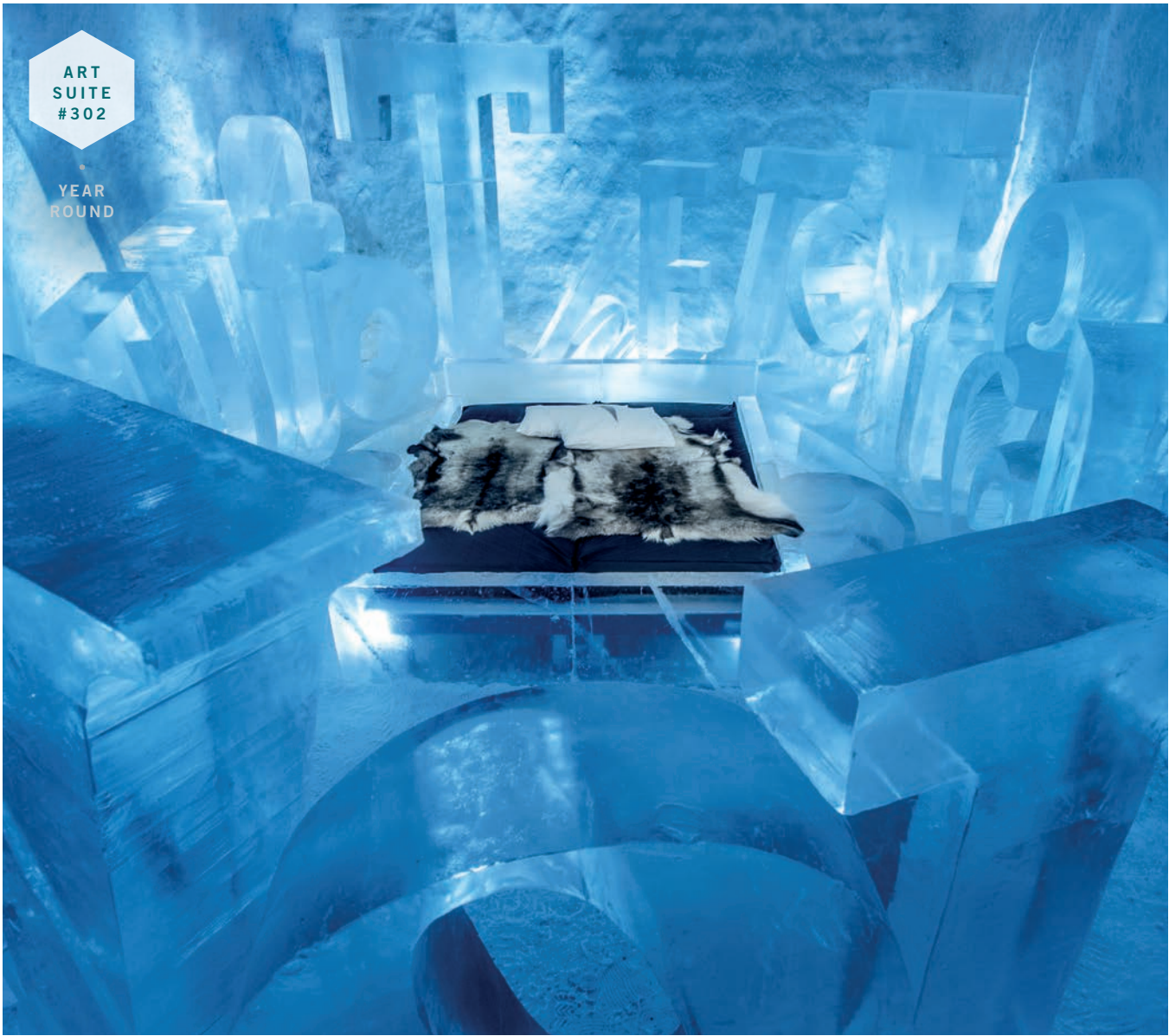

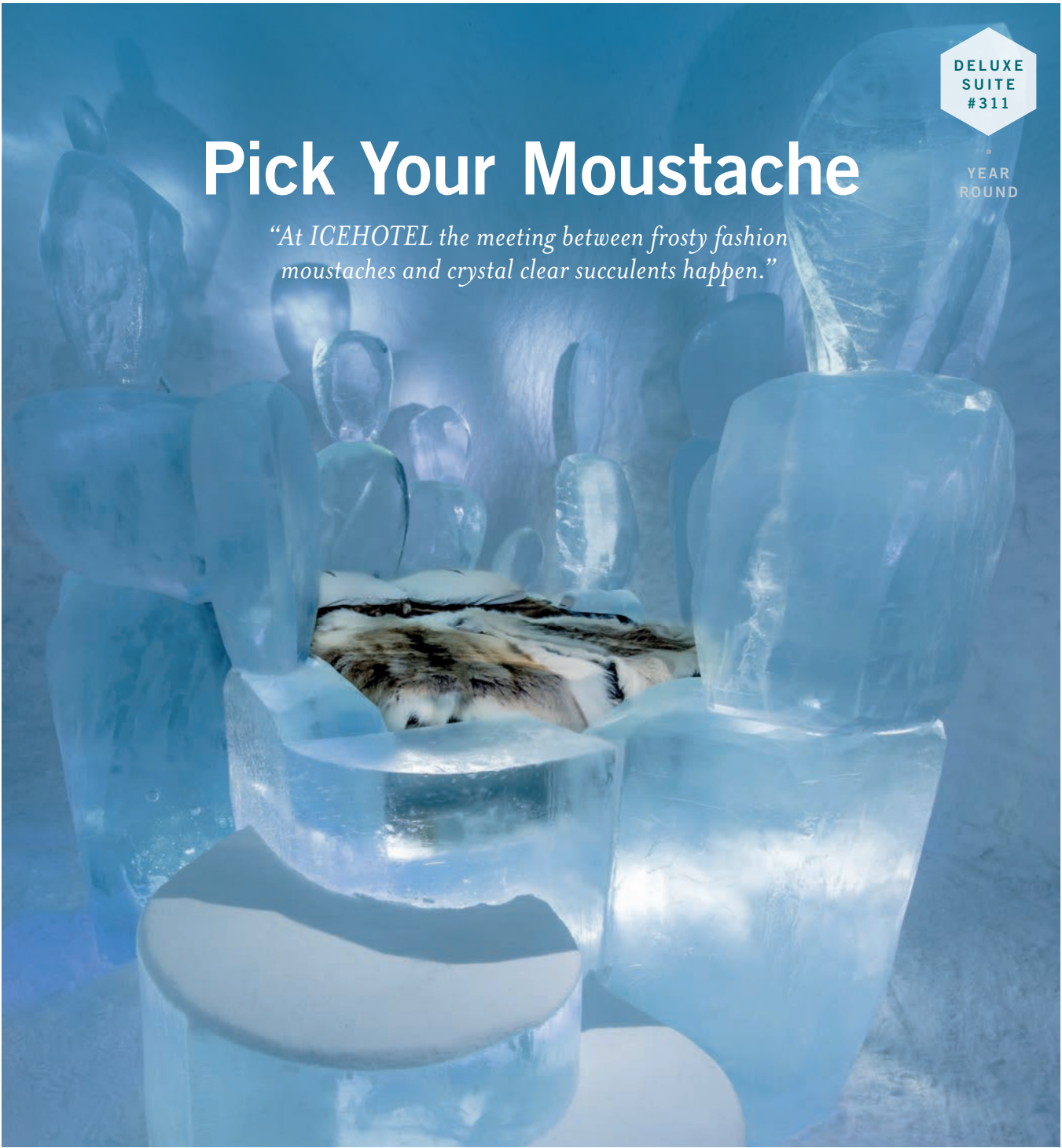

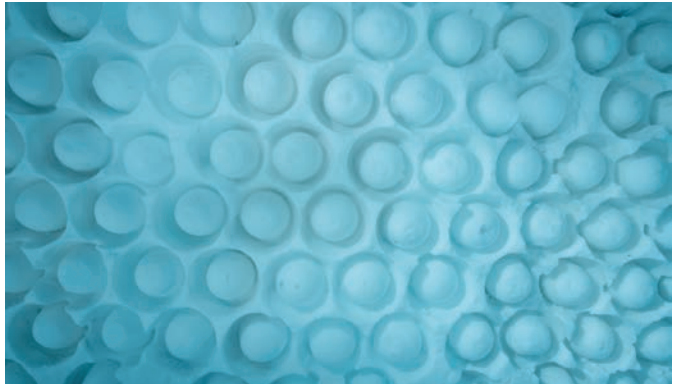
